Dr. P. R. Perumalswami (May 1, 1940 – October 29, 2017), hails from Parambakatoor, Kadukkampalayam village, near Gobichettypalayam in Erode district. He started his journey to the U.S. in 1964 in a bullock-cart to the nearby bus stand at Gobi and then by train and ship for several weeks. After his doctoral degree from University of Minnesota and tenure as a faculty at the South Dakota School of Mines, he mentored hundreds of young engineers for three decades at Ford Motor Company.

Dr, P.R.P. was one of the four founders of TNF in 1974 and was its Second President. He spent several weekends in the late 1970s travelling across the U.S. to establish TNF and enroll new Life Members. During the last few years of his illustrious life, he was silently working behind the scenes in supporting the Michigan Chapter of TNF and in mentoring the next generation of TNF leaders. His leadership and involvement in TNF continues to uplift several thousands of underprivileged Tamils.

Dr. P.R.P is survived by his dear wife Mrs. Vadivu, daughters Santhi, Ponni and Chithra, their husbands and three grand daughters.

TNF proudly honors Dr. P.R.P. posthumously with TNF Life Time Achievement Award for his life - long service and leadership to TNF.

Dr. P.R.P.'s legacy will live on as TNF continues its service mission in Tamil Nadu.

TNF's Vibrant Chapters Across America

Over the past few years, TNF has shifted the emphasis from mega national conventions to cost-effective and region/city - focused charity events organized by TNF Chapters. Following is a list of our Chapters and highlights on each one of them. If there is no Chapter in your area, we can help you start one. Austin Chapter – The Chapter has conducted three information sessions and has plans to conduct annual charity festivals in support of TNF projects.



Sangavai Ganesh, a youth from Austin, dedicated her arangetram proceeds to TNF ABC projects.

BayArea Chapter – San Francisco-based Bay Area Chapter was the first to start Tamil Schools in the U.S. which subsequently became California Tamil Academy. The Chapter is organizing information sessions and is planning on adopting a district in Tamil Nadu through the ABC initiative.

Boston Chapter – The Greater Boston Chapter organizes walkathons and has raised funds to provide scholarships to underprivileged students in Tamil Nadu and to support the ABC projects.

Central Florida Chapter – The Central Florida Chapter organizes information sessions and project meetings to promote TNF among the local community.

Central Ohio – Columbus-based Central Ohio Chapter successfully organized TNF's 43rd National Convention in 2017 and piloted a one-day convention model. Annual walkathon event and the youth wing's Birthday Registry (donating to TNF projects on their birthdays) are gaining traction. The Chapter supports ABC schools in Nagapattinam District.

Chicago Chapter – The Chicago Chapter has organized three National Conventions for TNF. It supports the ABC project in Cuddalore district and the women empowerment project in TNF Chennai Center

Cleveland Chapter – The emerging Cleveland Chapter has plans to conduct annual charity festival and support the district-focused initiatives of TNF.

Connecticut Chapter – The Chapter organizes annual Mother's Day events. It recently initiated the Kidney Disease Awareness (SIGARAM) project in Tamil Nadu and has supported Anbalayam (orphaned special needs children) and ABC education projects.

Dallas Chapter – The Dallas Chapter organized a walkathon in partnership with MetroPlex Tamil Sangam and donated the proceeds to ABC projects in Nagapattinam district.

Georgia Chapter – Atlanta-based Georgia Chapter is the leader in funding for eye camps in Tamil Nadu and is planning on hosting the TNF National Convention in 2019.



Houston Chapter -The Houston Chapter organized the TNF National Convention in 2012 and dedicated the funds raised from the convention to initiate the ABC project in Thiruvarur district. It celebrates Mothers Day in style which has become a favorite among Houston Tamil ammas and their fans!

Indianapolis Chapter – The Indianapolis Chapter in partnership with Tamil Sangam of Central Indiana helped raise funds to build the dormitory at Anbalayam.

Michigan Chapter – The Michigan Chapter has hosted a TNF National Convention and supports the Namakkal District ABC project. It also has taken a leadership role in promoting the TNF Service and Education Internships through its Tamil schools and annual charity events.

Milwaukee Chapter – The Milwaukee Chapter has supported flood relief, Andhra Mahila Sabha in Chennai, Swedish Mission Hospital in Thiruapathur (Sivagangai district) and eye camps in Kandanur (Sivagangai district).

Memphis Chapter – The Memphis Chapter organizes Valentine's Day and walkathon and supports ABC projects.

New Jersey Chapter – The New Jersey Chapter has partnered with New Jersey Tamil Sangam and Stage Friends (USA) to raise funds for several initiatives like Anbalayam, flood relief and education enhancement at Gurukulam in Vedaraniam. By hosting the 44th National Convention in 2018, the Chapter is helping raise funds for Kanavagam, a home for destitute children near Karaikudi, and for various districts in Tamil Nadu.

New York Chapter – NY Chapter was the first to celebrate Mothers Day among all the TNF Chapters. The Chapter has adopted ABC schools in Vellore and Namakkal districts.

Oklahoma Chapter – Tulsa-based Oklahoma Chapter has organized information sessions to support TNF projects.

Philadelphia Chapter – The Greater Philadelphia Chapter initiated the ABC initiative by providing the funds from the TNF National Convention it hosted in 2010. Through its Charity Festivals it supports the ABC projects in Sivagangai district. The Chapter was instrumental in buying 3 grounds of land and in building the first building at Anbalayam, which now has evolved as a role model TNF rural initiative.

Phoenix Chapter – The Phoenix Chapter has conducted information sessions and participated in other regional events to promote TNF to the local community

South Florida Chapter – The South Florida Chapter organizes Valentine's Day and participates in local events to promote TNF to the community. The Chapter supports ABC projects in Nagapattinam District.

Washington DC Chapter – The DC Chapter successfully hosted the TNF National Convention in 2016 and dedicated the funds raised to initiate ABC projects in Tirunelveli and Thoothukudi districts.

Western Pennsylvania – Pittsburgh-based Western Pennsylvania Chapter is one of the oldest Chapters of TNF. The Chapter successfully hosted the TNF convention in 2008. The funds from that convention helped test concepts on school education which enabled TNF to subsequently launch the now successful ABC education initiative.

MY EXPERIENCE WITH TNF INTERNSHIP

Vishok Gunasekar, Troy, Michigan

Over the summer of 2017, I traveled to Namakkal, India to volunteer as an intern in a school sponsored by TNF. As a volunteer teamed up with few other kids, I worked with seventh, eighth and ninth graders who struggled with their Math and English skills. As part of our work, we would plan, create practice problems and quizzes and try to connect them to the students' interests. A typical day would consist of teaching, hands-on learning, and review. All of the kids loved to review, and would often compete in teams to get the most number of questions right. The kids never hesitated and interacted very well. It felt good to teach the kids and it was a lot of fun.





This volunteering experience has impacted me in ways I never thought it would. I never knew about the conditions that kids lived in. Hearing about it and actually experiencing what happens are two different things. The thing that sticks with me to this day, is three kids coming up to me and asking

what it's like to be on a plane. In one of the schools I traveled to, the lights were broken. There were no fans and no doors in all of the classrooms, and class was taught outside. In another school, I asked one of the many kids why he was not eating. He told me he had to wait since they didn't have enough plates. If they didn't get a plate in time, they didn't eat. I had never heard about any of these issues. The things that we take for granted, is a luxury for them... like being on a plane, being able to learn in a well-facilitated environment and even eating food on time. This entire experience has opened my eyes to see in person about how kids around the world are living, and most importantly, how people, like me, can help those in need.

Inspired by this I have joined Build On and Red Cross to give back to the community. I believe students like me should use this opportunity to volunteer and experience this. If I have the opportunity, I would definitely volunteer again.



TNF- ABC Education Initiative

What is ABC Project and Why TNF Initiated the Project?

- Focus is on educating the poorest of the poor
- Government schools are our priority
- > 10 Million children go to 36,000 government schools across 30,000 villages in Tamil Nadu
- On an average, a third of the students in government schools are far below their grade level proficiency
- TNF has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Government of Tamil Nadu to serve inside the government schools during school hours



Focusing on the Academically Challenged

- Goal is to minimize school dropouts and motivate all students in adopted schools by enriching and empowering them with resources, programs, and tools currently not provided by the government
- Objective is to build a unique, sustainable and cost-effective statewide initiative that can be replicated in all 32 districts in Tamil Nadu
- Focus is on the entire student population, ranging from academically-challenged to highly ambitious students

What does ABC Stand For?

The 3 core components of the ABC initiative are:

- A-Achieving grade level proficiency
- B Boosting the morale
- C-Championing for higher aspirations

What are the Accomplishments to Date?

- Based on learnings from educational enhancement projects in Chengalput district, TNF piloted the ABC concept in Sivagangai district in 2011-12
- Successful acceptance by students, parents, teachers and educational officers resulted in expansion of the project to 10 districts across Tamil Nadu



College Tour for Government School Students

- TNF-appointed Project Coordinators and teachers living in the villages conduct the program in close collaboration with school teachers
- 26,868 students have benefitted through the ABC initiative, as of May, 2018
- 18,961 students in 58 adopted schools across 10 districts have been enrolled in ABC classes, conducted by TNF teachers, to achieve grade level proficiency and to integrate back to their regular class
- 6,934 tenth graders received two days of softskills training to boost their morale and life skills
- 973 students were taken on college tours and provided career guidance

CHENNAI DISTRICT

TNF Center

The TNF Center at Kilpauk is the site for TNF's administrative office that effectively implements projects all over Tamil Nadu. The Center is also an active project site that (1) fosters Science and Technology transfer (2) empowers women living in Chennai slums and (3) enriches the skills of students of all ages.



TNF Center Chennai

- The Tailoring Center, housed in TNF Center, has enriched the quality of life of more than 500 economically underprivileged women and their families by providing them tailoring training and tailoring machines.
- The Computer Training Center provided basic computer training in the 1980s and 1990s to a wide range of Chennai residents including students, housewives, retirees and general public.
- The Center for Medical Genetics (CMG), housed in the TNF Center, focuses on preventing birth defects with scientific research. CMG provides internship opportunities for American -Tamil students visiting India during their summer vacations.
- Entrepreneurship Incubation Center a floor in TNF Chennai Center has been dedicated to promote Science and Technology entrepreneurship, in partnership with Trichybased National Institute of Technology's Thiruchirapalli Regional Engineering College Science and Technology Entrepreneurs Park (TREC-STEP)



Tailoring Training at TNF Center

- Computer education (BCA and MCA online degrees) was provided through Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) and Tamil Nadu Open University (TNOU).
- An Art Gallery functions at the Center as a forum for budding and economically challenged artists to showcase their artistic skills and talents. The project, inspired by Mr. Ram Thukkaram and implemented by former TNF Chairman Mr. Sanjeevi, has empowered many unknown and needy artists. Other activities include art workshops, Art Exhibition by School of Arts and training for school children.

Chemkit

As Corporation schools in Chennai did not have basic science laboratory facilities, Dr. Anandakrishnan, former Chairman of TNF Chennai, came up with the Chemkit concept.

- Chemkit is a mini lab kit consisting of 50 chemicals, 16 reagents and glassware to conduct about 100 experiments

Flood Relief and Rehabilitation



New Homes for Flood Victims

- Food, vessel, provisions and stationeries were distributed to flood-affected people in JJ N a g a r, K o t t a i m e d u, Keerapalayam, Ottangulam and Gandhi Nagar areas
- Five medical camps were organized to help 800 flood victims
- Siddha Medical Camp in Sirupalaiyur, Boothambadi, Kallayankuppam. 6,600 people benefitted
- School dropout occurs more among the 'Narikkurava' community due to frequent floods in Cuddalore district. A special coaching center was conducted for these vulnerable children, enabling them to continue school after the floods.
- 135 quality houses were built in Sathamangalam I, Sathamangalam II, Vadaharirajapuram and Boothampadi villages. About 800 flood victims have been moved from damaged thatch huts to these well-built houses. Rs. 300 lakhs was invested in this long-term rehabilitation effort supported by many partnering organizations across the U.S.
- Repaired and renovated of 20 flood-affected Government schools at a cost of Rs. 28 lakhs, supported by individuals and organizations that donated for flood relief through TNF

School Education Pilot Project in Maduranthagam Taluk

- TNF Partnered with Kalanjiyam, a Chennai-based NGO, to focus on school education
- Four government primary schools, two middle schools and one government-aided school were chosen for the study conducted in Lathur block, Maduranthagam taluk
- Rs. 43 lakhs raised from TNF convention in Pittsburgh in 2008, under the leadership of Dr. Palanisamy, was dedicated to this multi-year pilot project
- Children were provided with uniforms and school supplies. Special teachers were appointed. Yoga and computer classes were included as part of the curriculum.






